Randolph J. "Randy" Staats, 76, of Claverack, passed away Thursday January 15, 2026 in the comfort of his home. Born May 31, 1949 in Hudson, NY, he is the son of John and Virginia (Wright) Staats. Upon graduation from high school, Randy served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War, earning a Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars. He was Honorably Discharged in 1969. Randy was a truck driver for the Columbia County Department of Public Works, from which he retired. Randy was truly committed to service throughout Columbia County. His involvement with the Hudson Elks Lodge #787, The Federation of Polish Sportsmen, American Legion Post #184, and VFW Post #1314 was beyond measure. Working at Bingo nights, coin drops on Fairview Ave., organizing parades, and placing flags and flowers on Veteran's graves, Randy was always there, passionate about honoring fellow service men and women. Randy was aide to two VFW State of New York Commanders.
