August 30, 1928 - June 21, 2020

Robert P. Delaney, Sr., 91, of Greenport, passed away peacefully on June 21, 2020, with his family by his side, at his residence in Delray Beach, Florida. He was born on August 30, 1928, in Hudson, to the late Margaret McNally and Bartholomew Delaney. He attended St. Mary's Academy, enlisted in the United States Navy and served aboard the U.S.S Carrier Leyte. On November 27, 1948, he married Mary Dolan, together they were married 71 years.

Bob worked as an internal sales manager for Foster's Refrigeration Corp., and during this time also held the position of 3rd Ward Alderman for the City of Hudson and was a Town Justice for 28 years for the Town of Germantown. He was also a member of the New York State Magistrates Association, Knights of Columbus and a lifetime member of the Rogers Hose Fire Company, Hudson Elks Lodge 787 and the Hudson Powerboat Association.
