Robert Leroy Michael, 78, of Hudson passed the morning of September 18, 2019 at Albany Medical Center.

Robert, who was known by “Bob”, was born in Great Barrington, Massachusetts and resided in Craryville, New York before relocating to Hudson. Bob was a graduate of Roe Jan, Mohawk Valley Community College and Oswego State University, where he obtained his Bachelor and Masters Degrees. Prior to obtaining his college degrees, Bob was in the United States Air Force for four years, having served overseas during Vietnam.

Bob, known by many of his students as “Mr. Michael”, was a technology teacher in the Hudson City School District for over forty years. Bob was also employed with the United States Postal Service for over twenty years.

In 1978, Bob married Beatrice Stichter and a year later their daughter, Leann Michael, was born. Bob is predeceased by his father, Leroy Michael, his mother, Olive (Nelson) Michael and his sister, Ann (Michael) Stupplebeen.

Besides his wife and daughter, Bob is survived by his sisters, Alice Mary (Michael) Hymel and Betty Lou (Michael) Russin, as well as his step-children, Kristine Warfield and Raymond Warfield, and his nieces and nephew.
