



Robert L. Myers

January 14, 1936 - August 13, 2022

Robert L. (Bob) Myers passed peacefully in the early hours of August 13, 2022, with his two daughters present. Bob was a lifelong Columbia County resident and graduated in the 1954 Class of Ockawamick High School towards the top of his class. He was awarded the prestigious Bausch & Lomb Award for his academia in Science. After four years in the Navy on the destroyer, USS Turner (DD/DDR 834), he began a 38-year career as an engineer for General Electric/Martin Marietta/Lockheed Martin/General Dynamics in Pittsfield, MA where he worked troubleshooting on Polaris, Poseidon, and Trident missile guidance beginning with the Mark 1 through present day Mark 6 systems.

Bob loved to hunt and fish with his father and brothers and creating beautifully handcrafted items for friends and family in his workshop. A quiet man at heart, he enjoyed gardening, an afternoon family picnic, going to breakfast and dinner, Sunday Nascar races, playing with family dogs, bowling, and impeccably caring for the family's home. Robert was also a lifelong member of the Philmont Rod & Gun Club, NRA, and former member of the Hudson Elks Lodge Post 787.

He is survived by his daughter Joan A. (Myers) Spencer (John), Jeff Taylor (Joan's former spouse); and daughter Beth A. (Myers) Harring (Robert Jr.); grandchildren, Carrie L. Harring, Brian A. Harring, Jessica A. Spencer, and

Jayme L. Spencer; great-grandson, Greyson J. Spencer; and several nieces and nephews.

He is pre-deceased by his beloved wife of 62 years, Janice E. (Stickles) Myers (deceased 2/27/22); grandson, Jeffrey R. Taylor; his parents, Guy W. and Minnie E. (Scheffel) Myers; and his siblings, Beatrice (Myers) Mahar, Leon Myers and Kenneth Myers.
