Robert H. Stickles, 68, of Livingston passed away Sunday May 4, 2025. Born September 9, 1956 in Hudson, NY, he is the son of Robert and Mary (Diehl) Stickles Sr.

Robert graduated from Hudson High School Class of 1974. After graduation he enlisted in the United States Navy and was stationed at Point Mugu, CA. Robert achieved the rank of Petty Officer First Class, was an Aircrew Survival Equipmentman Class A, and he was Honorably Discharged in 1978. Robert's career was with the New State Department of Corrections. He was hired in 1983 and his distinguished tenure was for 26 years, retiring in 2009. Serving his community, Robert was a Code Enforcement Officer in the Town of Livingston for 15 years. He was an avid pool player, and loved to travel. Driving a long distance for Robert was not an issue or challenge, 800 to 1000 miles a day was expected. Robert was a devoted family man, whose grandchildren was top priority.

Married May 2, 1981, Robert is survived by his beloved wife of 44 years Florence (Feller) Stickles. He will be remembered and forever loved by his sons and daughters in law Adam and Angelina Stickles and Brian and Caitlin Stickles, grandchildren Lilyanna, Charlotte, Ophelia and Theo. Robert is also survived by his sisters Linda Stoddard (Norman), Deborah Morgan (John), Janet Shumsky (Joe Loeffler) and Joanne Stickles (Larry Hildenbrand).
