April 27, 1938 - March 1, 2019

Roger Myron Marvin passed away March 1, 2019 in Orlando, FL, following a brief illness. Roger was born in Hudson, NY, to Myron and Mary Marvin on April 27, 1938. Following his graduation from St. Mary's Academy in 1955, Roger joined the U.S. Navy with four of his fellow graduates. In 1962, Roger joined the NYS Police, where he served for 25 years.

In his retirement, Roger enjoyed driving for the Healthcare Consortium and volunteering at fundraisers for St. Mary's Church, where he was a lifelong communicant. Roger was a life member of Roger's Hose Fire Co. and Hudson Elks Lodge 787. He was an avid reader, traveler, and anonymous good samaritan who enjoyed regular jaunts to casinos with his wife Jo Ann.

In addition to his parents, Roger is predeceased by his sister, Mary Anne Russell. Roger is survived by his wife of fifty-five years, JoAnn (Bruno) Marvin, and their children Lisa (Brad) Chew, Susan (Eric) Helsley, Roger T.
