Ronald Wood, 54, of Greenport, passed away Tuesday, October 29, 2013 at Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Born May 5, 1959 in Hudson, he was the son of Mary Augustus Whiteside of Hudson and the late Ernest Calvin Wood, Sr.

For the past year Ronald had been a counselor at Brookwood Youth Facility. He was a graduate of Hudson High School Class of 1977 and received his Bachelor's degree from SUNY Oneonta in 1983. He worked extensively with youth in various agencies throughout New York State. He had also been a teaching assistant in the Syracuse City School District.

Ronald was a sports enthusiast. He loved weight lifting and training. In high school he excelled in track, football, and basketball and at SUNY Oneonta he was on the basketball team. He was an amateur boxer and was the 1993 Amateur AAU Boxing Champ for the Niagara Region 165 lb weight class. Ronald was an avid fisherman and enjoyed photography.

In addition to his mother, surviving are his companion, Yvette Wood; two children, Shanequa Wood and Julian Wood; his brother, Ernest C. Wood, Jr. (Jeannette Henson) of Ohio; four sisters, Valerie A.
