



Rose Donne Curcio

February 25, 1929 - September 28, 2024

Rosemarie Donne Curcio, 95, a resident of Ghent, died on September 28, 2024. Mrs. Curcio spent her life caring for others. She was a loving wife and mother who raised her only son by serving as an example of strength and kindness. Born on February 25, 1929, in Hudson, she was the daughter of Anthony and Mary Agnes (Brunese) Donne. In 1946, Mrs. Curcio graduated from Roeliff Jansen High School. In 1949, she was a member of the first graduating class of the Columbia Memorial School of Nursing. Her working life was spent as a nurse, first at the Rip Van Winkle Clinic in Philmont, Columbia Memorial Hospital, Pine Haven Nursing Home and the Firemen's Home.

In the spring of 1950, she married Louis Curcio, Sr., of Hudson. She supported him in his work, often bringing him lunch at the barber shop in Philmont. In the home they built together and that she carefully tended to, she loved watching the birds, growing tomatoes for sauce, baking Banana Nut Bread. She lent a helping hand to all of her wonderful neighbors, and they often lent a hand to her. Those who knew Rosie will never forget her combination of strength and compassion.

Mrs. Curcio is survived by her son, Louis, Jr., and daughter-in-law, Jeanne, as well as several nieces, nephews, and cousins, including John Carroll and Phillip Carroll of Amenia, NY, Jean Leggett of Dover Plains, NY, and Edythe Dossin of Eastpointe, MI. She is predeceased by her nephew, Thomas Cody,

her lifelong friends Nancy Berninger and Marilyn Johnston, and Louis Sr., her husband of 62 years.
