Rosemarie Grandinetti Moon (Putty) passed away peacefully March 11, 2018, at the age of 88, lovingly surrounded by her family.

Born in Hudson NY October 16, 1930 to parents Angelo and Rose Margaret (Bucci) Grandinetti. Rosemarie weighed a robust 13 lbs. and was affectionately nick-named “Putsky” by her grandfather Antonio Bucci.
