On October 1, 2018 Sondra D. Patzwahl passed away peacefully at her home in Claverack, NY. Born in Hudson in 1939, she attended school there and graduated from Hudson High School. After high school Sondra attended Becker College until she married William B. Patzwahl in the late summer of 1959. Together they raised two sons with Sondra as a devoted mother and wife. She was always there for the family taking on jobs to help support and guide them. When the family was young she worked as a teacher's aide at their school, as later on she became a dental hygienist. Sondra supported the family tent rental business quietly working the critical administrative duties. As she aged and the kids moved off on their own, her support broadened and she moved onto volunteering within the community, as she did her family proud working at the Second Show in support of Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Sondra will be deeply missed by her family, as she leaves behind a brother Ron Cook (wife Laurie), two sons David (wife Barbara), and Jeffrey (partner Maryanne Wentworth), grandchildren Sarah Grace, Austin William, and Jessica Mary Patzwahl. Sondra was predeceased by her husband of 58 years William, and her parents Jerry and Fay Cukerstein.
