Sophie Wisowaty Orlich, 95, of Livingston, passed away Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Born August 31, 1920 in Germantown, she was the daughter of Joseph and Adella (Kozanowski) Wisowaty.

She married Anthony J. Orlich on November 24th, 1939. They were self-employed owners and operators of service stations in Red Hook and Bells Pond in Livingston. She was a member and past president of the Livingston Fire Company #1 Ladies Auxiliary, and a volunteer at Columbia Memorial Hospital.
