



## Stephen A. Molnar, Jr.

Stephen A. Molnar, Jr., 71, of Greenport, passed away Tuesday, March 1, 2011 at Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Born on Sept. 19, 1939 in Hudson, he was the son of Margaret (Fitting) Molnar of Hudson and the late Steven Molnar, Sr.
