



## Theresa Scott Kreig

Theresa Scott Kreig, 87, of Hudson, NY, passed away Friday, Jan. 28, 2011 at the home of her daughter.

Born on May 8, 1923 in Manhattan, Theresa was one of ten children born to the late Edley and Theresa Clarke Scott. She married her husband, the late George E. Kreig, in October of 1943.
