Thomas L. Koll, 94, of Greenport, passed away Friday, January 3, 2014 at Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Born in Ghent on March 24, 1919, he was the son of Otto and Bertha (Hannet) Koll.

Thomas was well known for his craftsman and carpentry skills in the Hudson area, where he owned and operated his own business.
