Wallace (Jack) J. Kilmer Sr., 90, passed away peacefully at home with his loving wife of 69 years, Norma Whitaker, by his side Thursday, September 25, 2014. He was born May 11, 1924 son of the late Wallace G and Clara (Rockefeller) Kilmer of Hudson.

Jack was a graduate of Hudson High School, before he entered into the Coast Guard. He was honorably discharged after serving as a seaman first class aboard the USS Marchand.DE249, during World War II. He was employed as Supt.of Mails at the Hudson Post Office until his retirement in June of 1979. He was a social member of the Greenport Fire Department, past active member of Edmonds Hose, Hudson, and member of the VFW post 10132 of Hobe Sound Florida. He was a long time member of the First Reformed Church of Hudson.

Besides his wife Jack is survived by his 3 sons, Stanley (Patricia) Kilmer of Hudson, Lawrence (Barbara) Kilmer of Catskill, and Wallace (Shelia) Kilmer of Port Richie, Florida.
