Wanda Waters Boyce, 91, of Hudson, New York and Stuart, Florida, died peacefully at home surrounded by her family on December 10, 2012.

Wanda was born July 16, 1921 in Hudson, New York, the daughter of the late Leroy and Emma (Miller) Waters.

She was predeceased by her husband of 69 years, Carl V. Boyce, who died August 18, 2012, as well as a brother, Leroy Waters, Jr., and three sisters, Gerry Conklin, Mayfred Waters, and Ruth Waters.

Wanda was an accomplished artist and poet. Her paintings are cherished by family, friends, and collectors alike. During the 1950's she modeled for artist Clement Donshea.
